The Realities of Advanced Medical Interventions

ICU Nurses Maureen "Koala" RN & Cathy RN, BSN

In this age of ever advancing medical technology it is difficult to stay "up to date" on the latest strategies to keep us well and thriving.

This presentation addresses, in frank terms, what Advanced Medical Interventions are. Actual outcomes for patients are discussed, for both the short and long term.

CPR, mechanical ventilation, dialysis, and medicines to support blood pressure are detailed. During the presentation, the audience will see some of the actual equipment used. This is an interactive session, with time for questions and dialogue.

Cathy and Koala work in an Intensive Care Unit. The ICU consists of adult medical and surgical patients who have sustained cardiac surgery, strokes, traumas, severe infections and lung disease. These patients typically require full or partial life sustaining measures. They will present in layperson's terms the realities of what these, often heroic, Advanced Medical Interventions mean to the average person and their families.

Nurse Cathy - BSN Certified Critical Care RN, 32 years of Nursing, last 24 years in critical care, nursing instructor and ICU educator.

Nurse Maureen "Koala" - RN, Certified Critical Care RN, 26 years Nursing in critical care. She is also a volunteer with the Whatcom Alliance for Healthcare Advancement. Koala is trained in advanced care planning and helping clients complete their advanced directives.
