FOUNDATIONS IN FAITH COMMUNITY NURSING/HEALTH MINISTRY*

This foundational course prepares currently licensed RNs for a **Faith Community Nurse (FNC)** ministry and other caring individuals for a role as a **Congregational Health Minister (CHM)** or as a **Community Health Advocates (CHA)** in an interfaith partnership of service to congregations and community

The HMN Foundations course includes 18 modules (providing 44 contact hours) designed to deliver whole person health and integrated programs in mind, body and spirit wellness. The first weekend sessions are held on site March 2 and 3. For the eight weeks these students will explore broader elements of spirituality in caring for the health needs of their communities

14 enrolled in this course. **Five (5)** are seeking the FCN designation; **three (3)** are seeking the CHM designation and **six (6)** are seeking the CHA designation.
